The University of Illinois [Pollinarium](#) is the first free-standing science center in the nation devoted to flowering plants and their pollinators. Why do plants and pollinators merit such special attention? The ecological interaction between pollinators and plants is vitally important because most terrestrial life on Earth depends in one way or another on pollination for survival.

Notes: The Pollinarium is located just off of Windsor between Lincoln and Race. You will see a sign and some beehives, followed by a gravel road. Turn north on that gravel road to reach the pollinarium.
